Play in the sand and then read Psalm 139:15-17. Wow!

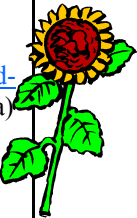
Check out your backyard today. Look for insects and small creatures that God created. Observe God's creativity and care. Can you paint or draw your own insect?
